

PLANT * GROW * EAT PROGRAM

This FREE program is available to K-6 schools in session during the San Diego County Fair. P*G*E starts in the spring with Fair staff visiting your school providing classrooms with all supplies (seeds, soil and containers) necessary to plant edible produce. Teachers are provided standards-based curriculum for planting and nurturing their produce. In June, classes take a field trip to the San Diego County Fair where their plants are judged and students awarded with a ribbon. Students and teachers may then explore the Fair and visit other educational exhibits.

PRODUCE OPTIONS:

K – 3rd grade: Radishes

4th – 6th grade: Choice of growing a salad basket, herb basket or edible flower basket.

DEADLINE: March 27, 2020

SCHOOL VISIT AND PLANT DELIVERY: April/May

FIELD TRIP DATES: June 5, 9-12, 16-19.

FIELD TRIP TIME: Groups must arrive between 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM. Groups will visit the Fair's farm to receive ribbons for their projects and learn more about how food grows.

Once the Fair opens to the public at 11am, groups may stay and explore the entire Fair.

COST: Students, teachers and chaperones receive free admission to the Fair. School buses park for free.
