 Entry Pick Up Thursday, July 7: 10am-4pm

ENTRY FEE

No fee – free for all teachers to enter classroom projects.

ENTRY LIMIT

One (1) entry per student or participation in one (1) group project.

ENTRY CHECKLIST

- Read entry materials, decide what to enter
- Enter online by deadline at sdfair.com/competitive-exhibits/ (make sure you receive a confirmation email)
- Print entry tags and secure to project/s before delivering (bring projects alphabetized by student name and grouped by class)
 - o For group projects, attach one tag indicating the highest student grade level, and provide a list of participating students at entry delivery.
- Deliver entries
- Check date for entry pick up

NEW THIS YEAR

- Fair Theme: Heroes ReUnite
- Use entry tag and identification label templates to identify your project/s before entry delivery (see last 2 pages).

ELIGIBILITY

Best of Pre-K – 6th Grade is a non-competitive exhibit showcasing student work entered by teachers in San Diego County and Tijuana Schools. Projects may be submitted as individual student pieces or group/classroom projects.

FAIR TICKETS AND RECOGNITION

Each student who participates with an entry will receive one (1) Exhibitor Access Pass. Be sure to join us on Fridays to celebrate “Kids Day” where kids 12 and under get in for free. Be sure to pick up your free ribbon. The teacher/leader of each group will receive two (2) Exhibitor Access Passes and one (1) classroom rosette for entering. All passes will be distributed at entry delivery.

ENTRY TAGS

All projects **must** be delivered with entry tags secured to project. Use the templates on the last 2 pages for each student entry and/or classroom project.

For group projects, attach one tag indicating the program supervisor, highest student grade level and provide a list of participating students at delivery.

When entering any combo classes or group projects, enter the highest-grade level in the field **Number of Tags**. There is no limit of students per teacher per class.

DELIVERY & PICK UP

Entry delivery instructions will be emailed following the entry deadline. If you are unable to bring entry on delivery date, you may send someone in your place.

A claim check will be issued upon entry delivery and must be presented at the time of entry pick up. If you are unable to pick up your projects, arrange for another person to bring in your claim check. Entries not picked up become the property of the San Diego County Fair and may be disposed of by August 1, 2022.

RULES

1. Local and State Rules apply to this competition, available at sdfair.com/competitive-exhibits/.
2. The 22nd DAA (San Diego County Fair) will not be responsible for loss or damage of any kind. No entry will be accepted should the exhibitor describe conditions under which they will exhibit.
3. Review your entry before completing registration and ensure that you have entered the correct number of projects.
4. All display decisions are the responsibility of the Program Supervisor and entries must remain on exhibit through the run of the Fair. Entries may be hung with Velcro, taped into “quilts”, hole-punched and bound into “books”, stapled, etc.
5. Copyright: Instructor’s signature on the online entry form verifies this is original student work.
6. Work must be in good taste and suitable for family viewing.

DIVISION 3000- SCHOOL PROJECTS

You may submit any classroom project (note, student entries **do not** have to be the same).

PROJECT EXAMPLES

Art/Crafts: Drawings, sculptures, collage, mixed media, weaving, etc.

Models: Missions, fire safe landscape designs, landmarks, etc.

STEAM/STEM: Graphs, life cycles, science documentations, multiplication tessellations, etc.

Community Service/Environmental: Projects done to benefit others or the environment such as a school garden, beach cleanup or classroom field trip such as visiting the elderly, etc. Must be documented.

Other: Biographical photography, pictographs, etc.

DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

Two-dimensional work may be individual, book bound, or combined in a “quilt”. Murals must be made of paper, canvas or cloth, suitable for hanging. Please **no** glass or framing.

- Quilts and Murals may not exceed 8’ x 8’
- Individual work may not exceed 12” x18” including borders
- Collage Boards may not exceed a standard poster board or tri-fold presentation board

Three-dimensional pieces must be free-standing.

ENTRY TAG

Attach this Entry Tag to the lower right-hand corner or bottom base of entry before delivery.

Print on white paper and use staple or tape to secure.

TIP: Do not tape to the front of the project or attach to the front surface of your artwork, etc.
