



Don Diego Statue


Background



Don Diego served as the San Diego County Fair's only goodwill ambassador. For generations, Don Diego — portrayed by Tom Hernandez from 1947 until his death in 1984 — welcomed visitors to the venue, escorted the Fairest of the Fair, and appeared at council meetings and community events.

The 22nd DAA Board in 1984 commissioned artist Maher Morcos to create a 16-foot bronze sculpture of Don Diego to symbolically welcome visitors.
