Registration Deadline:

All registrations must be submitted online in advance.
Space is limited to first 30 participants for each shootout.

Entry Fee: \$20 per person, per shootout (non-refundable)

Eligibility: Must be 18 years or older

Limits: One (1) entry per exhibitor per show

Where: Exhibition of Photography – East Grandstand, 2nd Floor

Schedule: June 23 or June 30.

Check-in at 4:30 PM – 5:00 PM at entrance of exhibit. Shootout at 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM.
Live judging begins at 7:00 PM in Veranda Café. All images will be compiled into a slide show and judges will comment and select award winners.

Awards: 1st Place - \$75, 2nd Place - \$50, 3rd Place - \$25. Ribbons will be awarded for first through third place. Winning images will be displayed in the exhibit.

Details: Each entrant will pick up your free admission pass to the Fair at Will Call on the day of the shootout. Bring your digital camera or cell phone and check in at the Exhibition of Photography. The theme will be announced and detailed instructions given. After 90 minutes of taking photos, you'll return and provide one image of your choice. We can download the image your from card. If you're using a smart phone, we'll give you an e-mail address to send your image, or you can share it via AirDrop.

NO DIGITAL ALTERATIONS or CROPPING are allowed except in-camera. Images using smart phones can't be edited outside of the pre-installed basic camera app.

NO TRIPODS are allowed because they can be a tripping hazard. Monopods are permitted.

By entering the competition, all exhibitors give permission to the Fair to reproduce their images in any of its publications, printed materials, slide shows, websites, or merchandise without additional compensation.
