Entry Fees

FRC: \$350.00 per entry

FTC: \$100.00 per entry

FLL: \$50.00 per entry

Entry fees are payable online with a credit card and are not refundable.

Fair Tickets and Parking

Participating teams will receive one (1) Exhibitor Access Pass per team member (up to 30 for FRC, up to 15 for FTC, and up to 10 for FLL) and one (1) parking pass per competition day.

How to Enter

- 1. After reading all entry materials, click the "Enter Now" link below to go to the ShoWorks Entry Homepage.
- 2. Register as an **Exhibitor**.
- 3. Select the appropriate division and class and input the required information.
- 4. Review your entry before completing registration to ensure that you have entered the correct division and class for each entry.
- 5. Click the check-out button and pay for all entries.
- 6. Read the confirmation statement and type YES. **Do not click multiple times**, as it will charge you each time.
- 7. You will receive a confirmation email with a summary of your entry(ies).

If you plan to make changes to your entries or need to leave ShoWorks at any time, SAVE YOUR CART before exiting out.

Fairbotics Best of Show Autonomous - Trophy

Celebrates the team that has demonstrated consistent, reliable, high-performance robot operation during autonomously managed actions. Evaluation is based on the robot's ability to sense its surroundings, position itself or onboard mechanisms appropriately, and execute tasks.

Guidelines:

- The award is based on the performance of the robot's autonomous (non-operator guided) operations during matches
- Consistent and reliable operation is weighted more heavily than the ability to score maximum points during any specific autonomously managed actions
- A team must be able to explain:
 - How the robot understands its surroundings, navigates the field or positions onboard mechanisms, and then executes tasks
 - The factors the team considered which could interfere with success during autonomously managed actions
 - The design, development, and testing that was done for the robot's autonomously managed actions

Fairbotics Best of Show Creativity - Trophy

Celebrates creativity that enhances strategy of play and was intentionally designed and not discovered.

Guidelines:

- A team must be able to competently describe the creative/ unique feature(s) and can trace its conception and design.
- Since creativity may involve risk of failure, the team should be able to describe how they mitigated that risk.
- The creative element's uniqueness has a practical application and contributes to the objectives of the competition.
- Developing the creative element contributed to the team's success on the field.

Fairbotics Best of Show Quality - Trophy

Celebrates machine robustness in concept and fabrication.

Guidelines:

- A team must be able to describe their quality plan i.e. how their design ensures robustness throughout the entire competition.
- The entire machine demonstrates quality: workmanship, welds, attachment systems, wiring, paint, etc.
- The machine can withstand the rigors of competition- maintaining functionality, including the use of designed-in redundancy and risk mitigation measures.
- Building the machine contributed to the team's success.

Fairbotics Best of Show F.A.I.R.S. (Application required) - Trophy Celebrates a team's alignment to our values here at the San Diego County Fair - Fun, A+ Quality, Integrity, Respect, Service.

Guidelines:

A team must describe how its attitude and work ethics align with the San Diego County Fair's core values.

- Fun- What activities, music, wardrobe, décor, etc. does your team embrace and how do they contribute to a fun and enthusiastic environment?
- A+ Quality- How has your team's pursuit of quality guided its engineering process, documentation, and competition presence.
- Integrity Describe an experience when your team members displayed honesty and humility with a success or a challenge.
- Respect Describe how your team creates a fair, ethical, and equitable environment.
- Service Describe how your team has engaged in meaningful service to others, whether through mentorship, education, volunteering, or outreach. Provide a statement from a community member or opposing team member.



FairBotics June 18 – 20, 2025 – Directions to the Venue

Important: Access to the Fairgrounds for FairBotics teams and volunteers will start at 7:00 am. Please remain in designated routes, parking, and/or event venue until the Fair officially opens at 11:00 am. Violation of this policy will result in revocation of privileges.

For vehicles Loading or Unloading Field and/or team robots only:

- Enter Stable Gate off Jimmy Durante Blvd. Access begins no earlier than 7:00 am.
- Follow route to Gate 19.
- Present your parking permit to Gate Attendant(s).
- Park in the designated area.
- Access to Arena parking is available only on load-in and load-out days.
- Please check-in at the designated Check-In Area.

Drop-off of additional team members and volunteers:

- Access the Main Lot via the Ride-Share Lot. (The Ride-Share Lot is for drop off only. No daily parking.)
- Proceed to the O'Brien Gate to enter the Fairgrounds. Access begins no earlier than 7:00 am.
- Present your Exhibitor Access Pass to the Gate Attendant.
- Follow the designated route to the Arena.
- Please check-in at the designated Check-In Area.

Parking for additional team members and volunteers:

- Access Horse Park off Via de la Valle (approx. ½ mile east of I-5). Access begins no earlier than 7:00 am.
- Present your parking pass to the Gate Attendant.
- Ride the free shuttle and disembark at the O'Brien Gate to enter the Fairgrounds.
- Present your Exhibitor Access Pass to the Gate Attendant.
- Follow the designated route to the Arena.
- Please check-in at the designated Check-In Area.

For all other attendees:

- The Fair will open daily at 11:00 am.
- Paid parking is available in the Main Lot or at Horse Park (with free shuttle service to the Fairgrounds)
 - starting at 10:00 am.
- Free parking is available at Torrey Pines High School (with free shuttle service to the Fairgrounds) starting at 10:00 am.
- Free shuttle service is available at the Solana Beach Coaster Station starting at 10:00 am.
