HOW THE AUCTION WORKS

The following pages will list all market animals by number in the following order of sale: Hogs, Chickens, Goats, Rabbits, Lambs, Turkeys, Ag Industrial Mechanics and Beef. The animal's weight, owner's name and affiliation (4-H, FFA or Grange) will be listed. The auctioneer will ask for bids in price-per-lot, with the exception of beef & hogs which will be auctioned at a price-per-pound. You can estimate the total price by multiplying the animal's weight by the price-per-pound. You may bid on as many animals as you would like by raising your buyer card. The bidding continues until a high bid is reached. A runner will bring a sales invoice to you for completion. Please see sample sale invoice and consult auction staff if you need assistance or additional information.

YOU HAVE JUST PURCHASED AN AUCTION ANIMAL

You have several choices to make regarding the disposition of that animal:

OPTION 1 • Donate your animal to the Don Diego Junior Livestock Auction Scholarship Fund. Check the box stating "Donated to Don Diego Junior Livestock Scholarship Fund." No more action is required.

OPTION 2 • Sell to Packer. Check the box marked "sell to packer." The packer price will be deducted from your final invoice. You will not take possession of the animal. No more action is required.

OPTION 3 • Send your animal to be processed. At check-out, a fee of \$225 for beef or \$125 for hogs, sheep, or goats will be charged and will include: pick up of the animal at the fair, feed, harvest of animal, refrigeration of carcass, delivery of carcass to custom processors of your choice. When completing paperwork, you must also select the Custom Processor where your meat will be cut and wrapped: **Cliff's Meats, Hottinger's Meats, Scott's Meats, Barstow Country Butchering, or Bisher's Quality Meats.**

OPTION 4 • Take the animal to your home and arrange for harvest and custom processing on your own. You must select "self-haul" and indicate who will be transporting your animal and their phone number. This procedure meets the requirements of California Department of Food and Agriculture Regulations, Chapter 4. Article 1, Section 900.

PAYMENT OF PURCHASES

Multiple buyers per lot are accepted and each buyer will be responsible for an equal portion of the sale unless otherwise stated. Non equal portions must be adjusted when the runner brings the sales Invoice to the buyer. We accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express. Buyers using credit cards will be assessed a 3% fee. The Fair will accept checks. All sales are subject to a 5% commission fee which is deducted from the exhibitor's final auction check. Please sign the sale invoice and make sure to complete the disposition section carefully. Changes to the disposition section will result in a \$40 change fee. **All auction purchase payments due day of auction.**

ADD ONS

Additionally, a buyer may add (minimum of \$25.00) to an exhibitor's auction check by submitting an add-on. This may be done in-person on Auction Day (credit card or check) or mailed to the Livestock Office (check only) no later than July 3. Payment through the online add-on ShoWorks system found on our website may also be made. Add-ons will be charged a 5% processing fee which is deducted from the add-on amount. No add-ons will be accepted for non-auction animals. Add-Ons will be accepted as soon as the sale order is ready (typically the day before the sale) and closes on-line July 3 at 9:00 pm.

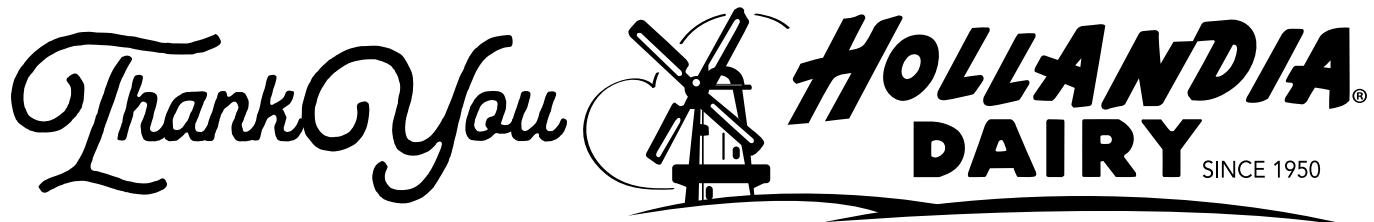

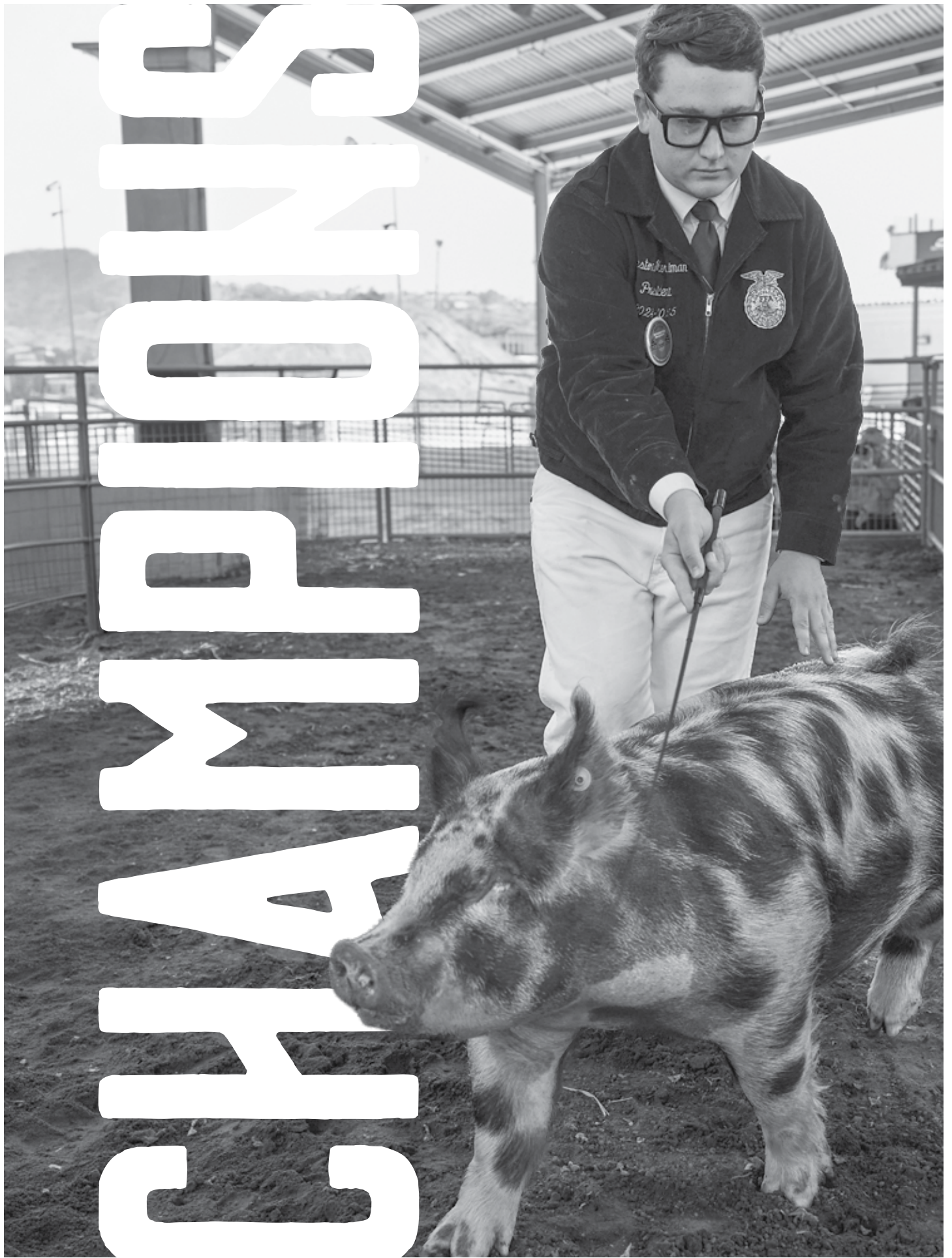

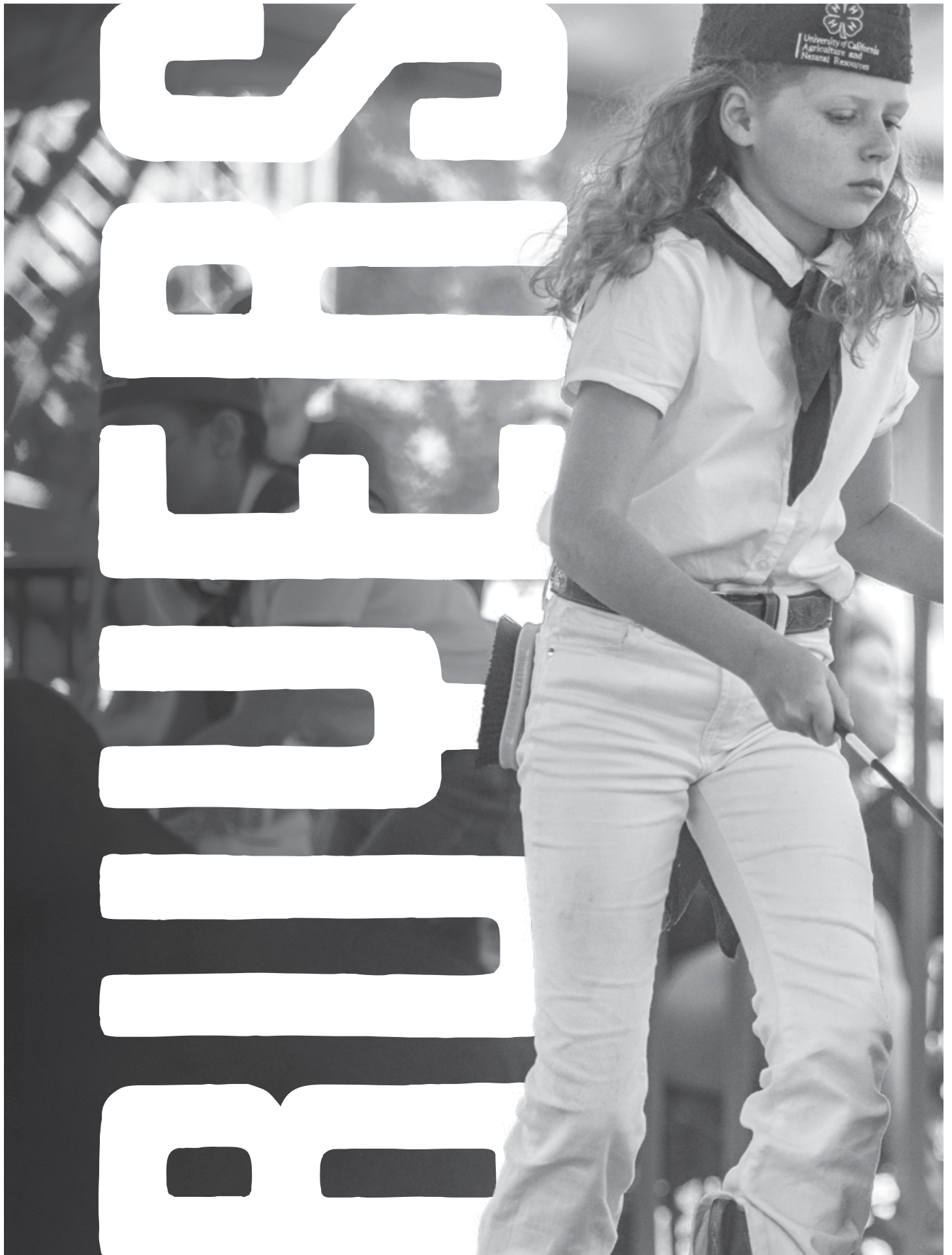
