Entry Pick Up	Thursday, July 6 • 10am–4pm

ENTRY FEE

- FREE for all teachers to enter classroom projects
- FREE for scout troop leaders to enter troop group projects

ENTRY LIMIT

One (1) entry per student or participation in one (1) group project

ENTRY CHECKLIST

- Read entry materials, decide what to enter
- Enter online by deadline at sdfair.com/entry
- Print entry tags and secure to project/s before delivering (bring projects alphabetized by student name and grouped by class)
- For group projects, attach one tag indicating the highest student grade level, and provide a list of participating students at entry delivery.
- Deliver entries
- Check date for entry pick up

ELIGIBILITY

Best of Pre-K–6th Grade is a non-competitive exhibit showcasing student work entered by teachers in San Diego County Schools. Project entries may be individual student pieces or group/classroom projects. There is no limit of students per teacher/per class. If combo class, enter the highest grade level represented.

FAIR TICKETS AND RECOGNITION

Each student who participates with an entry will receive one (1) Fair Entry Ticket. The teacher/leader of each group will receive two (2) Fair Entry Tickets and one (1) classroom rosette for entering. All tickets will be distributed at entry delivery.

ENTRY TAGS

All projects **must** be delivered with entry tags secured to each project. Use the template on the last page to create entry tags, or create duplicate Avery labels that mimic the template format.

For group projects - attach one tag indicating the highest student grade level represented and present a list of participating students at delivery.

DELIVERY & PICK UP

Entry delivery instructions will be emailed following the entry deadline. If you are unable to bring entry(ies) on delivery date, arrange for someone else to deliver for you. Similarly, if you are unable to pick up on the pick-up date, arrange for someone else to pick up.

Entries not picked up on pick up day become the property of the San Diego County Fair and will be disposed of promptly.

RULES

Local and State Rules apply to this competition, available at sdfair.com/entry

1. The 22nd DAA (San Diego County Fair) will not be responsible for loss or damage of any kind. No entry will be accepted should the exhibitor describe conditions under which they will exhibit.
2. Review your entry before completing registration and ensure that you have entered the correct number of projects.
3. All display decisions are the responsibility of the Program Supervisor and entries must remain on exhibit through the run of the Fair. Entries may be hung with Velcro, taped into “quilts”, hole-punched and bound into “books”, stapled, etc.
4. Copyright: Instructor’s signature on the online entry form verifies this is original student work.
5. Work must be in good taste and suitable for family viewing.

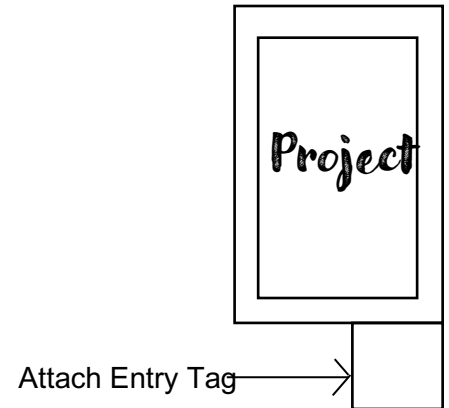
Note: Student entries do not have to be the same.

DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

Two-dimensional work may be individual, book bound, or combined in a “quilt”. Murals must be made of paper, canvas or cloth, suitable for hanging. Please **no** glass or framing.

- Individual work may not exceed 12” x 18” including borders. Quilts and Murals may not exceed 8’ x 8’
- Please NO glass or framing.
- Please do not use glue sticks for adhesive (projects fall apart).
- Collage Boards may not exceed a standard poster board or tri-fold presentation board

Three-dimensional pieces must be free-standing.

DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

Submit documentation of project on a tri-fold presentation board. Include photos and a write-up.

Attach one tag indicating the highest student grade level represented and, at deliver, present a list of participating students.

ENTRY TAGS: Print on card stock for best results. Attach to bottom right corner of project.
