



EXHIBITION OF FINE ART • WILDLIFE IN ART CONTEST

Fine Art Division: 1005

ELIGIBILITY: Adults age 18 or older. Artwork must be the work of the exhibitor.

LIMIT: One (1) entry per exhibitor.

CONTEST DATE: Thursday, June 29

ENTRY REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Tuesday, June 27

CONTEST REQUIREMENTS: Enter your wildlife painting of animals found in the great outdoors. Artwork must be no larger than 20" x 20" of painted area (excluding frame). Artwork may be framed. Computerized graphics will not be accepted. Judging will be of artwork only. **Exhibitors must personally deliver their entry.**

Please pre-register at sdfair.com/entry • There will be NO on-site registration.

LOCATION: Contest entries must be delivered to the fountain area; located in front of the Fine Art Exhibit building, east Grandstand.

PARKING: *Free* parking is available at Torrey Pines High School. Parking at the Fairgrounds or Horsepark may be purchased online prior to the contest date. Free shuttles are available from all parking locations to the Main Entrance.

EXHIBITOR PASS: One (1) Exhibitor Access Pass, for each registered participant for this date only, will be available at Will-Call on the day of the contest.

CHECK-IN: Fine Art staff will check in your artwork between 11am and 2pm on day of contest.

JUDGING: All entries must be delivered to the judging area no later than 2pm.

AWARDS: The following will be awarded in each class:

- First Place: \$50
- First through Fourth Place – Ribbon

Awards will be presented after judging. Entries will be returned to the artists following the awards presentation. Award-winning artist will be given the option of displaying their work in the Fine Art Exhibit through July 4 (pick up on July 6).
